Airline Begins Three Daily Flights to Melbourne, Fla. from Charlotte, N.C.

TEMPE, Ariz., Feb 11, 2010 (BUSINESS WIRE) -- US Airways (NYSE:LCC) today launched year-round service from Charlotte, N.C. to Melbourne, Fla., offering Melbourne customers the ability to connect to more than 125 domestic and international destinations through the airline's largest hub. All three daily flights will be operated by wholly owned US Airways Express carrier PSA Airlines, utilizing 70-seat Bombardier CRJ700 regional jets.
