NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals for the **Fuel Facility Improvements Project** will be received by the CITY OF MELBOURNE AIRPORT AUTHORITY at the office of the Executive Director, Melbourne International Airport, One Air Terminal Parkway, Suite 220, Melbourne, Florida 32901 until **Tuesday, March 9, 2017, at 2:00 PM EST** at which time proposals will be publicly opened, read aloud and submitted for evaluation. The Melbourne Airport Authority (MAA) is seeking proposals from qualified Contractors for the **Fuel Facility Improvements Project** located at the Orlando Melbourne International Airport, Melbourne, Florida which will include the following scope of work: concrete foundations, installing two 50,000 gallon horizontal above-ground tanks for Jet-A fuel; fuel piping, catwalks, automated fuel management system, fuel level measurement equipment, exterior coatings, chain link fencing and electrical work. Late proposals will not be accepted.
